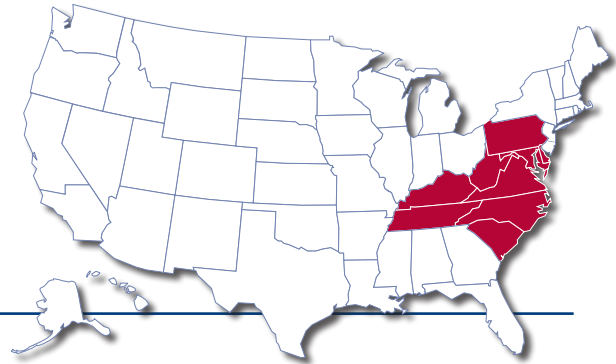
Mike and his wife Elaine have three children. Michael's other interests are hunting, fishing and attempting to play golf.
